Dear Parishioners:

From: Deacon Peter' Desk

The first reading is from the Book of Jonah. In this reading we only hear of the success of his call to repentance for the Ninevites. While it is wondrous to hear of one's success in doing the work of the Lord, it is important to understand Jonah and his feelings.

First, Jonah hated the people of Nineveh. Second Jonah knew his God is a God of mercy. So when God asks Jonah to tell the Ninevites they have 40 days to change their ways and repent for their evil-doing, Jonah tries to escape from God by going in the opposite direction -away from Nineveh. He thought that by leaving the vicinity he could escape God's request. The ship Jonah boards is beset by a severe storm. The crew determines that the cause of the storm is Jonah fleeing God. To save themselves and their ship, they throw Jonah overboard. Jonah is swallowed by a large fish and is thrown up three days later at the point where he left! God calls for Jonah to go to Nineveh again and he goes. This is the point where today's reading takes up the story. When the people repent and God changes his mind about destroying them, Jonah goes off to sulk in the desert. God raises a large bush to give Jonah shade, but Jonah is still angry and grumbles about the bush. God sends a worm to destroy the bush's root. Jonah now grouses about the death of the bush. God explains all the good he has done for the people of Nineveh, and especially for Jonah. Continuing to sulk, Jonah slowly begins to see things God's way.

So what can we learn from this? God loves - us, all of us. God is forgiving, if we but repent of our evil-doing. And God has a great sense of humor. How else could he possibly continue to love and to put up with us?
