From: Deacon Peter' Desk

Today's reading from the Gospel according to Mark tells of Jesus' healing ministry, starting with Peter's mother-in-law and then the people of Capernaum. Jesus also drives out evil spirits from those who have them; always silencing the evil spirits so that they cannot tell the people that he is 'the Holy One of God.' The evil spirits are supernatural beings and they are able to recognize supernatural beings so they recognize Jesus for who he is. Jesus silences them because the people need to recognize Jesus for who he is on their own! Just as we are to recognize Jesus for who he is on our own. We are not forced to believe. We are taught (catechized) about Jesus, but belief comes from recognizing and accepting Jesus as he is.

This is in keeping with God's plan from the very beginning. God wants us to love him, but he does not command us to love him. True love cannot be coerced into being.

Paul was an enemy of the Followers of the Way, but Jesus called him in a very dramatic fashion. He became not only a believer, but an advocate and an evangelist. Paul went forth to the Gentiles and brought them into the faith by preaching the Word of God. He says he does this freely; that is, without requiring payment for his message. Other than priests and deacons, how many evangelists do you see today who remain poor in their ministry? If the preacher is requiring pay for his ministry, what is his message?
