Dear Parishioners

From: Father Joseph's Desk

On February 14th we enter the Holy Season of Lent. Ash Wednesday Masses are at 8:00am, 12:00noon and 6:00pm at St. Joseph's.

Lent is a time for each of us to delve deeply into our lives and actions. It's a period of time to enter that desert, where we can begin the healing process of change in our lives. We wear more than physical clothing to cover our naked selves. We also cover our nakedness with a specific ethnicity, language, religious identity, culture, political affiliation, ideology, set of moral judgments, and a whole gamut of private wounds and indignations. These are in essence our outer garments. But we also possess a deeper inner garment. Our real identity lies underneath.

When Our Lord washed the feet of his apostles, he took off his outer garment. In order to let go of the pride that blocks any human being from stooping down to wash the feet of someone different from oneself, Jesus had to strip off a lot of outer things: pride, moral judgments, superiority, ideology, and personal dignity, so as to wear only his inner garment.

What was his inner garment? His inner garment was precisely his knowledge that he had come from God and was going back to God,. Therefore all things were possible for him, including washing the feet of someone whom he already knew had betrayed him.

During this Holy Season of Lent, may each one of us re-connect to our inner garment. Our inner garment is the image and likeness of God is inside us. When we are in touch with our inner self, we can find the strength to wash one another's feet across any divide. Only then can begin to feel sympathy for one another beyond our own wounds and differences!
