From: Deacon Peter' Desk

The First Sunday of Lent, we celebrated the Rite of Election for our RCIA Catechumens and Candidates. They have entered their Period of Purification and Enlightenment. The third, fourth and fifth Sundays of Lent we will be doing the "Scrutinies" at the 11 am Mass. The Prayer of the Faithful will be offered for them and we will pray over them with a minor exorcism to aid them in their purification prior to fully initiating them as Christians.

Being fully initiated means they will receive the Rites of Baptism (if they have not been baptized), Confirmation and Holy Communion. The celebration of these Rites will take place at the Easter Vigil. Yes, that is the proper order in which the Rites are to be received. So far, we only do this order with adults. The Eastern Rite Churches still follow this sequence, even with infant Baptisms. The Roman Rite Churches reserve First Holy Communion and Confirmation until the children receive sufficient catechesis to more fully appreciate the meaning of the Sacraments.

Those who have entered the Church through RCIA already know this, so this is just information that those who are unfamiliar with RCIA. But the primary reason is so you will continue to pray for all the people who are coming into the Church through RCIA or who are completing their Rites of initiation through adult confirmation programs such as Maria is conducting.

Book Study starting 3/15/2018
