## *From the Desk of Deacon Peter*

"Unless a grain of wheat..." This is a parable of Jesus that is another warning to his disciples that his own death is not only imminent, but necessary for his teaching to become fruitful.

There is more than a grain of truth in this parable. Because of Jesus' death and resurrection, the disciples are filled with the strength of the Holy Spirit and lose their fear. They even suffer martyrdom for their belief in what they learned from Jesus. Not only the disciples, but their followers also frequently became martyrs for the same cause. More important, many more joined the Followers of the Way and eventually became known as Christians. Today there are Christians spread throughout the world!

How could Jesus have explained to the disciples what his death and resurrection would mean to the world in any other way? We see the meaning of this parable now, but how could Jesus have described what was going to happen any better?

### Book Study starting 3/15/2018

Fr. Edward Hays, an artist and an author, has written many books to help us to grow in our Spirituality and Faith. For our continuing book study, we have chosen a book of his parables.
