Guide for The Chalice for Vocations Program

The purpose of The Chalice for Vocations Program: increase the number of people praying for vocations via fervent and devotional prayer.

The Eucharist is central to our Catholic faith and parish life; The Chalice for Vocations encourages families, individuals, and groups to pray for vocations. It is from within His family that our Lord grew in wisdom and grace; it is in the family and St. Joseph's community that we sow the seeds of vocations to the priesthood and religious life.

How it works: Families, individuals, and groups make a commitment to receive The Chalice for Vocations and pray for vocations for a designated week; they receive The Chalice at a mass of their choosing. Following Holy Communion, the presider calls the designated party/parties to the foot of the altar. The Chalice is presented, and the recipients are commissioned (in front of the congregation) to pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. The family/individual/group takes The Chalice home and publicly displays The Chalice where they will gather and pray for vocations daily. Prayers are provided in The Chalice for Vocations Program Guide and Prayer Book. The Chalice also serves as a visual reminder to say a personal prayer for vocations throughout each day, even when not praying from The Program Guide and Prayer Book. The following weekend, 30 minutes prior to mass, The Chalice is returned to a designated location. The presentation of The Chalice is rotated throughout all masses. *It is crucial that the entire parish is aware of The Chalice for Vocations Ministry and the need to support the program in perpetuity.*



Please incorporate a Daily Prayer for Vocations, even if St. Joseph's Chalice for Vocations is not present. Be confident that your prayers are heard.

Daily Prayer for Vocations

Father, You call each of us by name to follow You.

Bless Your church by raising up dedicated and generous leaders from our families and friends who will serve your people as sisters, priests, brothers, deacons, and lay ministers.

Heavenly Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named, we thank You for calling our family to become a sanctuary of life and love. Fill us with Your Holy Spirit, so that we grow in faith and holiness as a domestic church. Give us grace to forgive one another as You have forgiven us, be with us as we carry our crosses together. Help our family be a school of virtue; help us exemplify and teach love, respect, patience, obedience and gratitude in all circumstances. Father we ask that Jesus, Mary, and Joseph protect us and remain our constant guiding-example to ever-greater union with You. Amen.

Leader: O God, we recognize the responsibility all Your children have to pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. As part of our commitment to this responsibility, together we pray...



ALL: Lord Jesus, remove all distractions and noise from the hearts and ears of the men and women You are calling to a life of service. Make each person keenly aware of Your presence as they pray for guidance, particularly in the quiet moments of each day. Lord, if you choose a member of our family guide each of us to respond with a grateful heart. Amen.

ALL: *Our Father*, Who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us. Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. Amen.

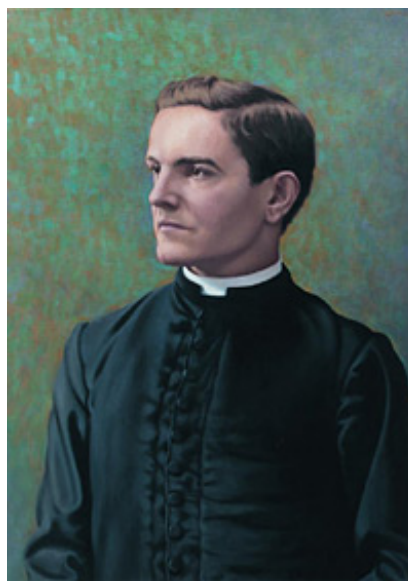

Leader: O God, we all recognize the responsibility each of us have to pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. As part of our commitment to this responsibility, together we pray...

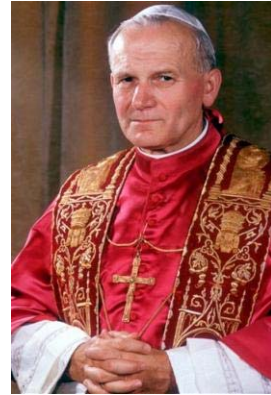

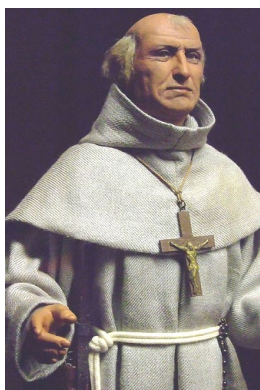
Leader: O God, we recognize the responsibility of all to pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. As part of our commitment to this responsibility, together we pray...

Serra Clubs

An organization of Catholic men and women of all ages. Lay members from all walks of life who have taken their name from Blessed Father Junipero Serra (pictured above), a Franciscan Missionary Priest who established many Missions in California (in the late 1700's) through his evangelization. There are over 670 Serra clubs with more than 21,000 Serra members in 35 countries. The objectives of the organization are to foster and promote priesthood and religious vocations, in the Catholic Church, by working together and praying together. Our Church needs strong leadership. Laypersons must help call forth priests, sisters, brothers, permanent deacons, and lay ministers. It is equally important to affirm those who already serve the Church so that they will continue to find their vocation a fulfilling way of life. We do so by recognizing our Priests and Religious on their birthdays and the anniversaries of their ordination or profession.

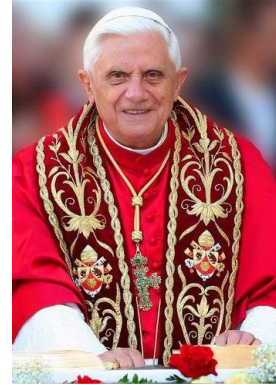
Memorare
