

Attention Parishioners!

After 15 years of priesthood in the diocese of Pueblo a priest has an opportunity to request a 6 month sabbatical for continuing education. After 25 plus years of Priesthood, Fr. It is possible that the replacement will be temporary and Fr. Steve will return in December or the replacement will be permanent and Fr. Steve will receive a new assignment.
