In the end, Jesus promises that God will separate what is true from what is false, gathering the faithful into His kingdom and removing all that destroys life.

My dear St. Joseph family,

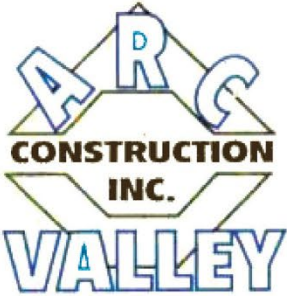
