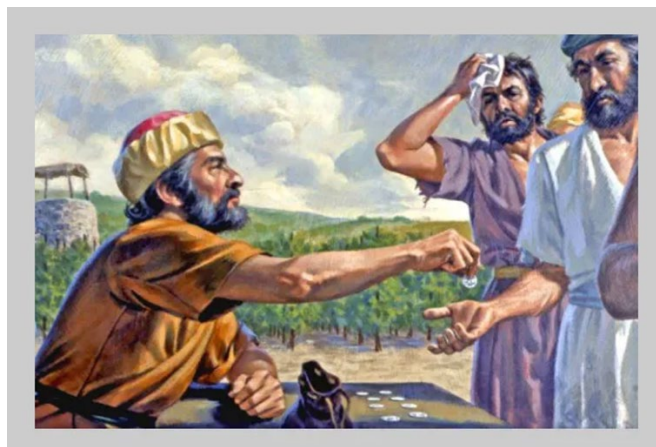

The generosity of the landowner reveals a God whose mercy is not measured by human standards, but poured out simply because He is good. This parable invites us to let go of the habit of comparing ourselves with others and instead rejoice that grace is given freely, even to those who arrive late. In the end, the vineyard teaches us that God's love is not a wage we earn, but a gift we receive.

From the Pastor's Desk

My dear people of St. Joseph, thank you for the prayers you offered for the success of our clergy retreat last September 14–17. Your intercession carried us into those days of silence and renewal, a steady light guiding our hearts. Every moment of rest, every spark of inspiration, every grace received was strengthened by your love for your priests. You reminded us that even when we step away for spiritual renewal, we never walk alone. Please know that your prayers have returned to you as renewed commitment, renewed energy, and renewed love for our parish family.



Our parish community is facing a difficult moment — not only because of the arson at Christ the King and the removal of statues at St. Anne, but because these incidents remind us of our shared responsibility to safeguard what God has entrusted to us. As your pastor, I ask each of us to be more attentive, more proactive in reporting concerns, and more united in protecting our sacred spaces. Yes, we must strengthen our security measures — but even more, we must strengthen our stewardship and care for one another. Let us continue cooperating closely with our fire and police departments, whose swift and dedicated response reflects their commitment to our safety. Their vigilance encourages us to be vigilant too, not out of fear, but out of love for our parish family.

At the same time, these events invite us to deepen our understanding of what it means to be a faith community in Pueblo. We are called not only to pray for peace but to cultivate it through kindness, respect, and solidarity with all our neighbors. When one parish or organization suffers, the whole city feels the wound — and the whole city is invited to respond with compassion. Let us be a parish that models this response: calm, courageous, and rooted in the Gospel's call to love beyond boundaries. May our shared commitment to mutual care become a quiet but powerful witness that turns fear into hope and division into unity.

In all these challenges, God is shaping us into a people of courage, tenderness, and faith. May we continue to walk together, protect one another, and let Christ's light shine through us.

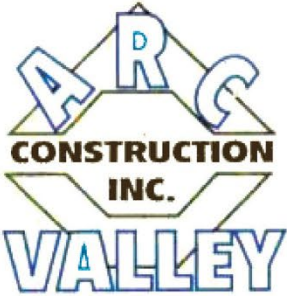
