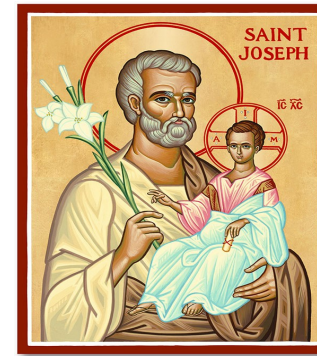

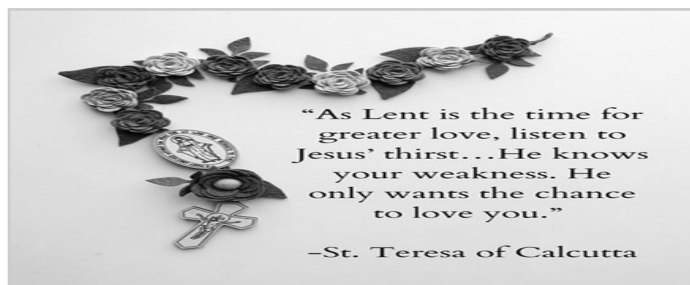
### A Spiritual Pilgrimage for Lent

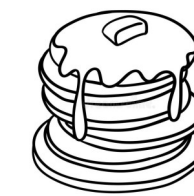
