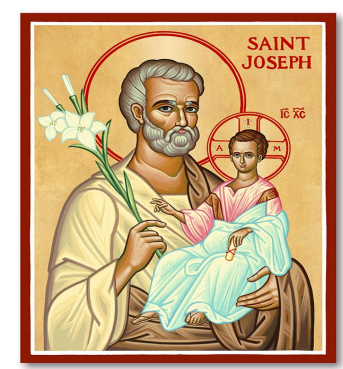

As the holiday season is quickly approaching, your help and support is greatly needed.


Because of your generosity, St. Vincent de Paul is able to provide Gift Certificates from King Soopers to help many in need purchase a meal for the holidays to feed their families.
